

NEWBORN I V SHIRT

Supplies:

- 1 or 2 soft fabrics
- Thread
- 1/4" Velcro or cut to size

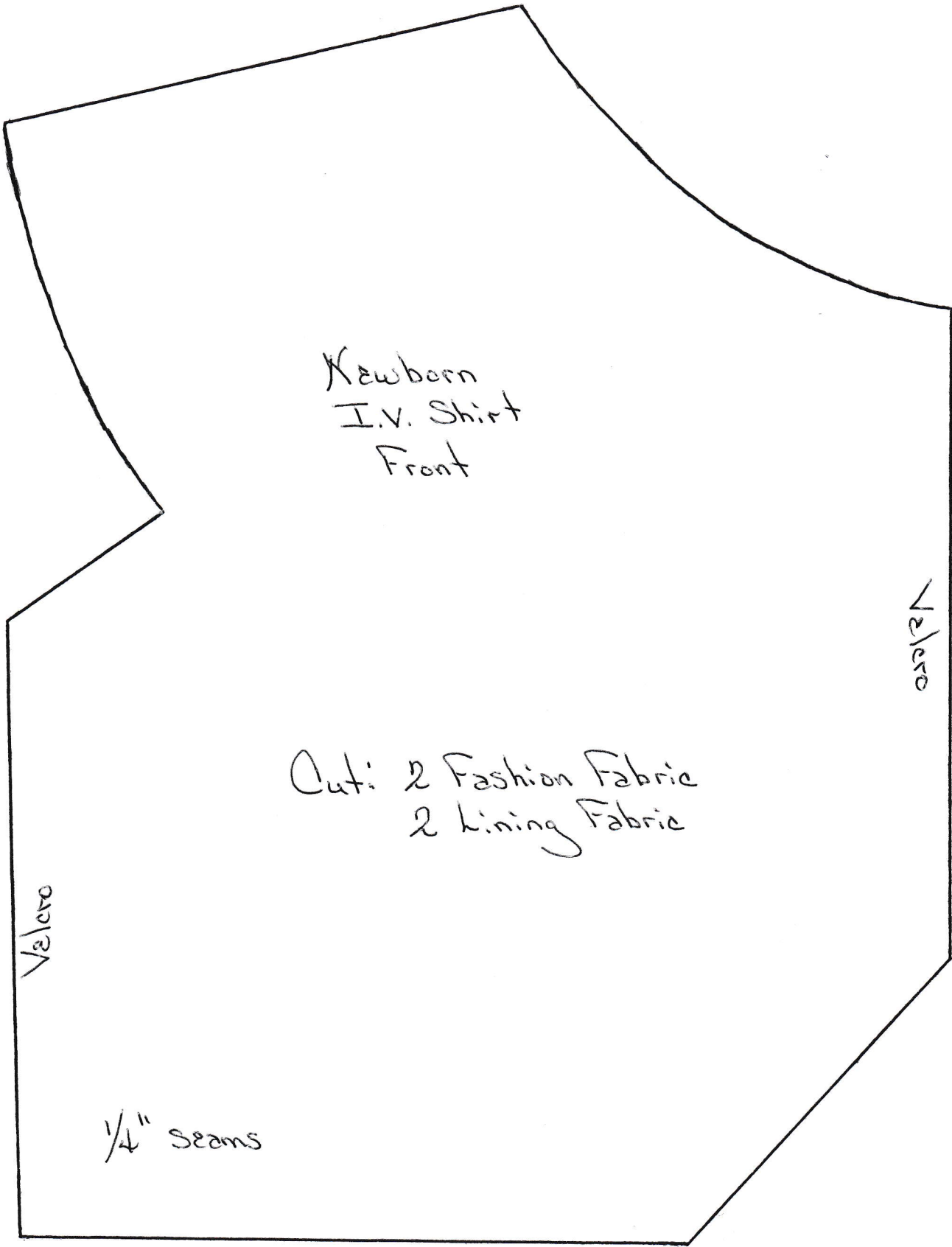
Directions:

Use 1/4" seam allowance

1. Sew shoulder seams for each fabric.
2. Press seams open
3. With right sides together sew around the outside edge leaving an opening to turn.
4. Clip seams
5. Turn and press
6. Slip stitch opening closed
7. Top stitch around the outside edge.
8. Sew the loop side of the Velcro to the right side of the back sides
9. Sew the fuzzy side of the Velcro to the wrong side of the front sides.
10. With the IV shirt facing you sew the loop side of the Velcro to the right side of the front opening.
11. With the IV shirt facing you sew the fuzzy side of the Velcro to the left side of the front opening.

NOTE: it is important to apply the Velcro in this manner so it doesn't scratch the baby.





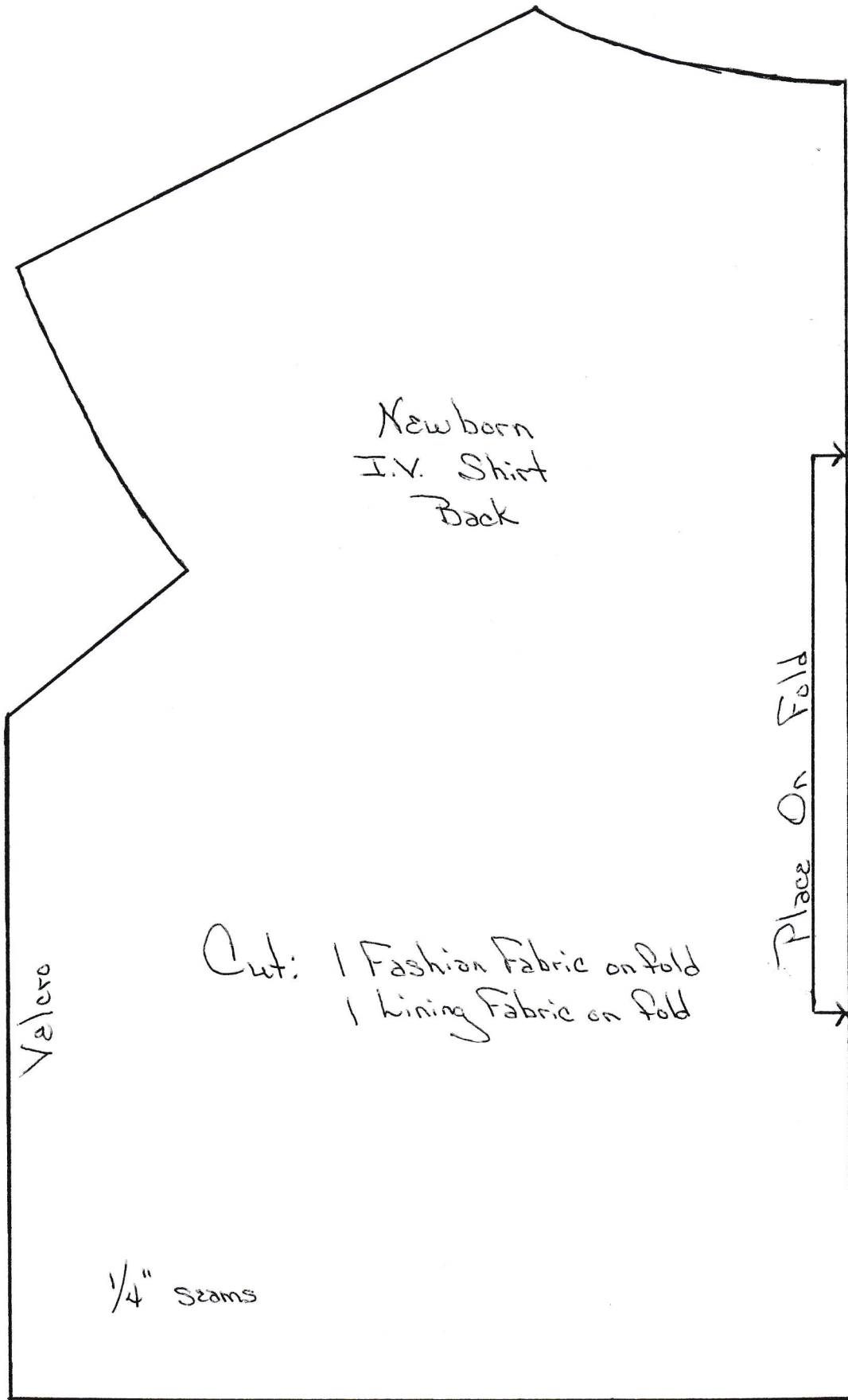
