

Good size for newborn booties is 3 to 3 ½" at foot (not stretched). 4" is too large for newborns

Newborn Knitted Booties

Lighter 4 ply (#4) yarn or sport weight (#3) yarn

Size 5 or 6 needles

Cast on 38 stitches

Knit 10 rows

Purl 1 row

Knit 16, knit 2 together, knit 2, knit 2 together, knit 16

Purl 15, purl 2 together, purl 2, purl 2 together, purl 15

Knit 14, knit 2 together, knit 2, knit 2 together, knit 14

Purl 13, purl 2 together, purl 2, purl 2 together, purl 13

Knit 12, knit 2 together, knit 2, knit 2 together, knit 12

Purl 11, purl 2 together, purl 2, purl 2 together, purl 11

Eyelet row: Knit 1, *yarn over, knit 2 together*, repeat across row, end yarn over, knit 1 (27 stitches)

Purl 1 row

Do knit 1, purl 1 ribbing for 6 rows. Or you can knit 6-7 rows to look similar to the bottom of the bootie.

Bind off loosely leaving a long tail to use to sew seam.

Sew back and bottom seam.

Single crochet a cord to run through eyelet row or use ribbon
